Press simulate in the top toolbar and use the default settings. What we want to check is the Von Mises stress and the displacement, these are usually the most important simulations. Before starting a stress study, you should always try to create goals on why you're conducting the study, this way it will be easier to see if your design is ok.

Typical process for Stress Analysis. Set expectations Estimate physical behavior using a conceptual model. Preprocessing Define material and boundary conditions (loads and constraints), and specify contact conditions and any mesh preferences. Solving Run the simulation to solve your mathematical representation, and generate the solution. To find a result, the part is divided into smaller elements.

Inventor Stress Analysis workflow. To start the stress analysis process, select an appropriate material for the part. The material must meet simulation requirements, like non-zero positive values for the Young modulus, Density, and Yield strength. For the Poisson ratio, the value is between 0.0 to 0.5.

I make y (distance to neutral axis) to be 6mm or 0.006m. Therefore the bending stress using the equation I mentioned in the earlier sentence to be 715 MPa. Now the stress in the linear axis ZZ is

much closer to my calculated result, coming in at 730 MPa and the stress in YY is 223 MPa (see screens below).

Close the dialog box without creating the constraint. Apply. Create the constraint and keep the dialog box open. More. Expands the dialog box to reveal additional controls pertinent to the command. Use Vector Components. Select to apply a displacement along with the fixed constraint.

Define the stress-free temperature (normally room temperature) for the model by applying a load type of "Initial Condition". Set the sub type to "Temperature". Enter the stress-free temperature. Entities do not need to be selected because the initial temperature applies to the entire model.
