Levophed (Norepinephrine) is a potent alpha/beta-agonist causing vasoconstriction and an increase in blood pressure. It is used for severe hypotension, shock, or bradycardia. Mix 4mg levophed in 250ml of D5W, making the drip 16mcg/ml. The standard effective dose is 2-12 micrograms/min. This drug has a rapid onset and short half-life.

* Use is restricted to the ICU setting and is only used as a continuous drip * Used most commonly in patients with HTN crisis situations and/or patients with aneurysms. * Dosing 0.1 mcg/kg/min to 10 mcg/kg/min though higher doses are rare due to fear of cyanide toxicity. * Titration is usually done in .1 mcg/kg/min increments.
